### Yallambee Village Meals on Feet Accreditation

Yallambee Retirement Village were accredited by the Aged Care Quality and Safety commission for the Meals on Feet service this year. The compliance report has been received in October and we are proud to announce that we are fully compliant with our accreditation standards. As part of the recommendations from the commission, it is now a requirement for all Village Meals on Feet residents to have their Care Plans reviewed every regularly. This is to ensure the meals and service that is provided, consider any medical and dietary requirements, along with any risks associated with the service. All staff undertaking the delivery of the service have completed their First Aid certificate ensuring staff are trained if a medical emergency arises during the meal service delivery.

We are also currently undergoing a review of the meal packaging to provide the best options for the main meals and salads, and to ensure meals are well presented to encourage meal satisfaction.

Yallambee staff are looking forward to growing and enhancing the Meals on Feet service, to support our residents with their daily meal choices.


